#### Stewardship Reflection

"...as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must forgive." (Colossians 3.13)

Forgiveness - one of the hardest things for people to do. It's amazing how long we can hold a grudge or be angry with someone. As we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family, take this opportunity to give the gift of forgiveness to someone - maybe someone in your family, maybe a coworker or neighbour or, maybe yourself.

Today's readings provide us with a glimpse of an extended Holy Family that is much larger than the nuclear family of Mary, Joseph and Jesus. Abraham and Sarah are the subjects of today's first two readings. As patriarch and matriarch of Israel they demonstrate their fidelity and trust in God and help us learn of God's fidelity to them and us.

In today's Gospel, Mary and Joseph as faithful Jews come to the temple with their newborn to fulfill the law of Moses. They meet two faithful Israelites; Simeon, a devout man waiting for the promised Messiah, and Anna, a prophetess who worshiped God with prayer and fasting day and night. These four remind us of the countless generations of Israelites through their fidelity and trust in God's promises to their people, now fulfilled in the child before them.

Simeon's prophecy about the child tells us that not only is this child the fulfillment of God's promises to Israel, but "a light of light of revelation to the Gentiles" His family includes all peoples.

This week as we meditate on the holy family in the temple let us seek to follow their example of faithfulness and trust God's covenant and look to the family that is holy to God, the family he came to save, the family of all peoples on earth.




**Reflection:** "The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favour of God was upon him." Luke 2:40
