Who Is Worthy?

By this time, we are well into Jesus' public life, his Galilean ministry, the one he began in Nazareth.

But this Sunday contains a surprise development. Isaiah, Paul and Peter are each expressing their own worthlessness! Three of the greatest witnesses in the Bible!....

When people meet the holiness of God head-on, they are therefore able to glimpse by contrast the humanness in themselves. They see that humanity seems full of holes like a sponge. None of them can any longer pretend that they shine like the stars because they see the real star bursting with light.

Experience of God let them understand that they are far, far less than God.

This is not bad, it is good. A falsely supposed importance cannot make us holy. But God can make us holy.

We can be proud to be unworthy if reception of God's love is a result. At Mass we echo that famous Roman centurion: "Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed" (Mt 8:8).

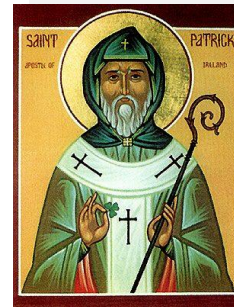
I suppose we could we react with shame; but notice that God does not say in return, "I reject you," but "I love you dearly. Come be with me, you fine human being."
