*"Go, eat rich foods and drink sweet drinks, and allot portions to those who had nothing prepared."* (Nehemiah 8:10)

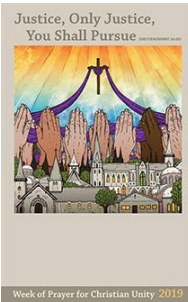
