Happy Birthday

Happy birthday to the Catholic Church! Happy birthday to you, who are the body of the Church! Christian Pentecost not only commemorated the Holy Spirit's visit but also marked the birth of the Christian Church.

The word Pentecost is Greek and it means "50th day." Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and their followers, and the beginning of their Earthly ministry to make disciples of all nations. At Pentecost, when the apostles prayed together, the Holy Spirit descended on them. *"Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them"* (Acts 2:3). They received the "gift of tongues" – the ability to speak in other languages – and immediately began to preach about Jesus Christ to Jewish people from all over the world who were in Jerusalem at that time

Church Improvement Projects Update:

Selection of a contractor to complete the replacement of the Church roof has been finalized through in informal tender process. Several local contractors were contacted and have provided prices according to the established scope of work.

Work will include the removal of all existing shingles on the sloped sections of the roof. The roof will be reconstructed with new flashings, the addition of 3” rigid insulation and covering with 24ga standing seam metal roof sheets over Tyvek. Price quotations from qualified local contractors which have been received for this project indicate a price range between \$198,315.00 and \$292,000.00

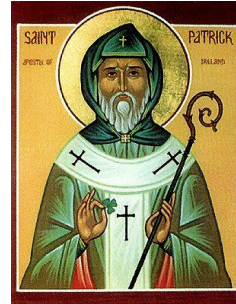
The lowest price quotation will be accepted with work to be scheduled for completion in August 2019
