

Ignoring our interdependence, we imagine that we can "go it alone" and end up dividing ourselves onto isolated units of races, classes, and genders, living as though we do not need the other. We may even reach the point of living as though we do not need the Other.

We struggle with the demon of power. We begin by setting ourselves above others, and often end with oppressing them, using our power in a cruel or unjust manner to keep others down.

We struggle with the demon of pride, imagining ourselves better than others, the "top dog" in our little world, or number one in the world.

Lent is a time to struggle with the demons, to "rid ourselves of the hidden corruptions of evil.
