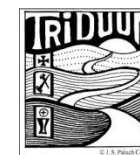

### Your Guide to Holy Week.

Today, Palm Sunday, marks the beginning of Holy Week, which leads us into the most solemn celebration of the Church year, the Triduum.



**Holy Thursday** – At this Mass, we celebrate the Lord's Supper. In Scripture, it is the night Jesus celebrates the Passover with the apostles, washes their feet, and celebrates the first Mass. During this Mass, we perform the washing of feet with 12 volunteers from the parish.

**Good Friday** – On Good Friday, we celebrate the Passion. In Scripture, it is the day that Jesus was crucified at Calvary. At both services (1:00 & 3:30), we have the opportunity to venerate the Cross at the altar. Good Friday begins and ends in silence.



**Stations of the Cross** on Good Friday at 6:00 pm. There are materials to borrow on the table in the foyer.



**Holy Saturday** – The Easter Vigil takes place at night as we wait and celebrate Christ's resurrection. We light the new fire and Paschal Candle and celebrate Christ's resurrection in the sacraments of initiation.

**Easter Sunday** – It's our most holy celebration in the Church as we magnify Christ risen for all! It's a time for family, comradery and love with joyful music and jubilation as we give thanks, praise and glory to our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

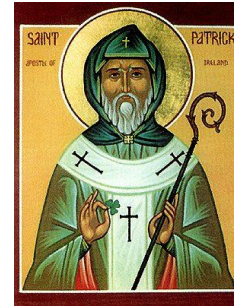
