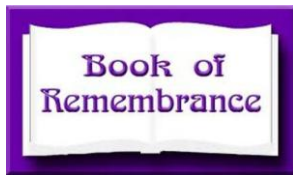

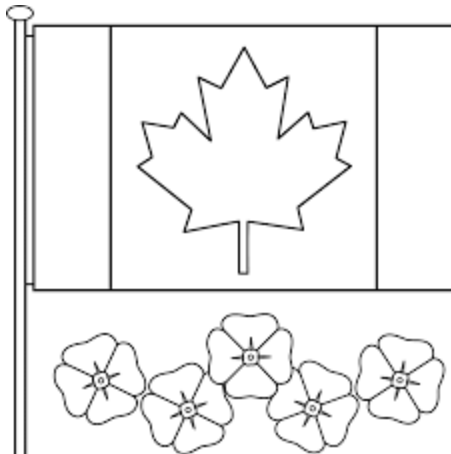

- Remember, the most important part of home is love.

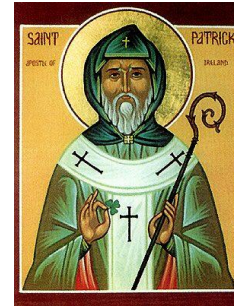
