BIG NEWS! Increased Attendance Capacity for Masses

We are excited to announce that in consultation with Bishop Jon Hansen, we have applied for and received approval to increase attendance at masses from 60 people to 80 people! This change is effective immediately.

Please remember:

1. Do NOT come to church if you are feeling sick, have a runny nose, cough or fever
2. Maintain 6' social distance at all times
3. Sanitize your hands when entering the church and use a disinfectant wipe to clean your pew when you arrive and when you leave
4. Communion MUST be received onto your open hand. At this time it cannot be received on you tongue

Current membership of the PPC includes: Roberta Giroux (chairperson) Nara Dapilos (vice-chair) Lea

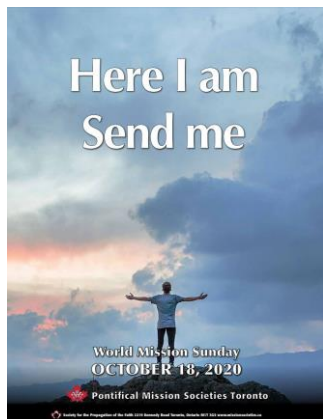

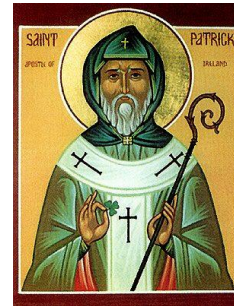
