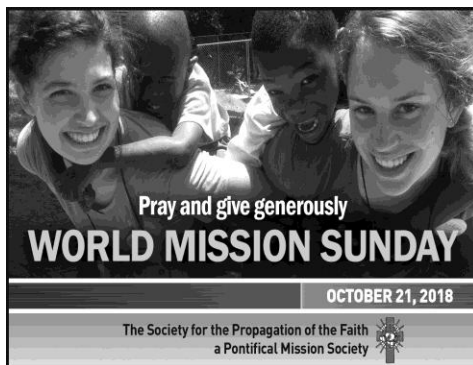


World Food Day

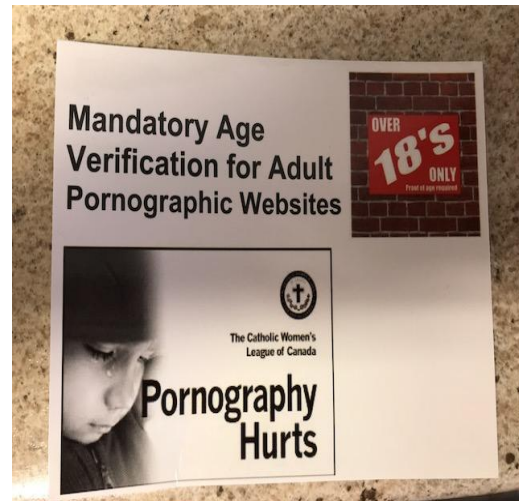

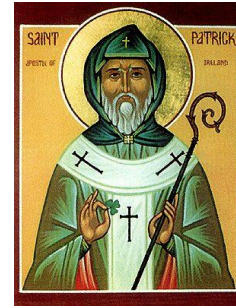
