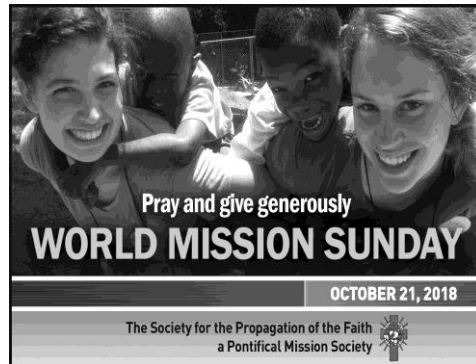

- Please offer your prayers for the work of the Church in the missions today and be as generous as you can on World Mission Sunday.



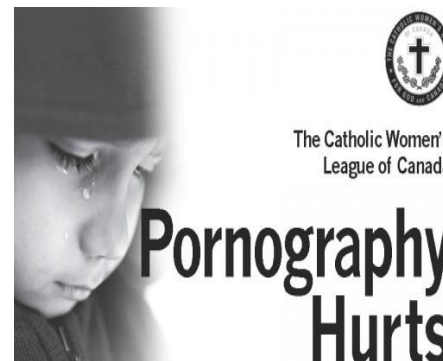

Stewardship Reflection

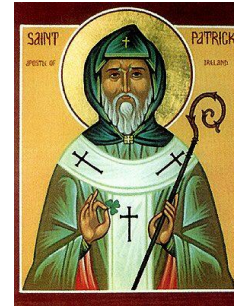
"For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many. (Mark 10:45)
