This event is sponsored by the Parish Pastoral Council, and for more information, please contact Dan Costache, event chairperson.

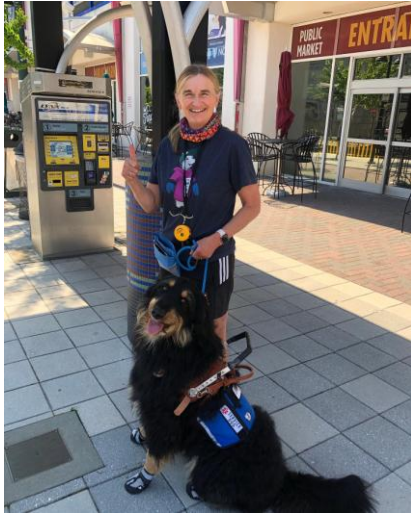
First Reconciliation and First Communion Preparation

INTRODUCING: Jane and Goliath



Goliath is a 2 yr old Bernedoodle that has been certified as a Mobility Support dog. As such he received over 300 hours of specialized training as part of the "Healing Canines" ' Service Dog program in Charlotte North Carolina. He was specifically bred into the Recherché breeding program, (European Bernese and hypoallergenic Poodle mix) he received an initial 13 months of puppy training and obedience work. This socialization, public access training amounts to 570 hours of training before the suitable dogs are moved into specific task work for the additional 300 hrs.

Goliath along with me has recently passed his Canine Good Citizen test, the Advanced Canine Citizen test, the International Public Access Test and has been registered with the American and Canadian Kennel club as a trained service animal.

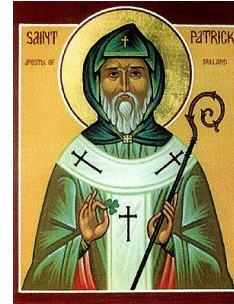
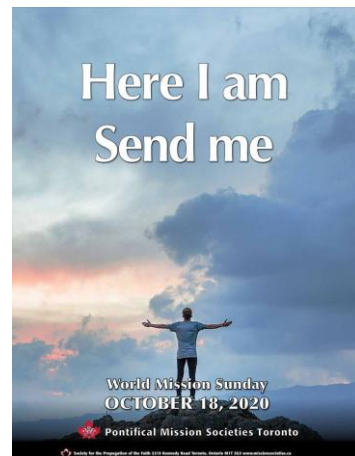
Healing Canines /not for profit organization is run by the renowned service dog trainer Rebecca Golian who trains many guide dogs, PTSD dogs, Allergen alert dogs as well being one of the few that trains Mobility Support Dogs. Goliath has been trained to counteract and support, retrieve and block, pull and assist in my daily living and functionality, adding valuable support and assistance in my fight against the degenerative spinocerebellar ataxia (ADSCA type 3) that I inherited. He has also been trained to react to any inherent psychiatric changes and offers a level of comfort to my family.

St. Patrick's Parish is pleased to welcome Goliath in his role as a highly qualified Service Dog and we celebrate his role in making it possible for Jane to continue to be an active member of our faith community.

Only on-duty, certified service dogs, like Goliath, will be permitted in the church with approval in advance by the pastor.
