Then, maybe, the RCIA is for you at this stage in your life.

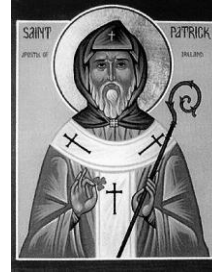
RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults
The RCIA is a sacramental journey; a process leading to initiation into the Roman Catholic Church. The process is about developing (or deepening) a relationship over time with both God and the Catholic faith community. The RCIA process follows the ancient practice of the Early Church and was restored by the Second Vatican Council as the normative way to prepare adults for baptism and full entry into sacramental life.
