Completed forms accompanied by a baptism certificate can be dropped off at the school offices, or the Parish office. **Deadline for registration is September 28 – No late registrations will be taken.** There will be a meeting for parents/guardians on Sunday, September 30 at 1:00 pm at the church.

RCIA: The first session for RCIA candidates will be Saturday afternoon at 3:30 pm. Through this program, you may be baptized (if necessary) and receive the sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. The program examines the teachings, beliefs, and practices of the Catholic Church.

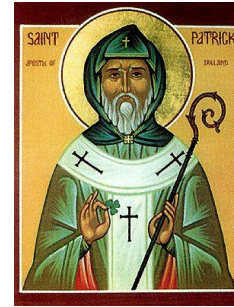
