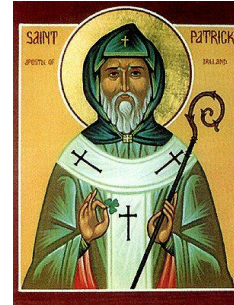
A Reflection: The Debt of Love
